POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT

The Tennessee College of Applied Technology Crossville is accepting applications for a full-time faculty position in the Industrial Maintenance and Electrical Systems modified program. Applicant must be willing to work a four-day per week work evening schedule. This is a non-tenure track faculty position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- High School Diploma or equivalent and post-secondary credential in electricity required. Current state electrical license and associate degree preferred.
- Three (3) years of experience in the occupation to be taught.
- Must be proficient in residential, commercial, and industrial electricity with extensive knowledge of the National Electrical Code. Experience with mechanical maintenance, motors, electromechanical controls, A.C. variable frequency drives, programmable logic controllers, hydraulics, pneumatics, robotics, and blueprints. Welding skills a plus.
- Must possess excellent planning, organizational, and communication skills for the effective transfer of knowledge and skills to students for job placement of graduates in the field.
- Willingness to acquire new skills and remain current in the field is also required.
- Be willing to learn and use individualized instructional techniques.
- Must have excellent professional ethics.
- The ideal candidate will be an enthusiastic, team player whose career objectives include being a member of a dynamic and growing college that has a vision to expand its services and increase its offerings to the citizens, businesses, and industry in its service area.

GENERAL DUTIES:

- Develop teaching outline and determine instructional methods utilizing knowledge of specific training needs and effectiveness of such methods as individualized and group instruction, lecture, demonstration, and conference.
- Maintain student records and reports.
- Responsible for student placement and assist with student follow-up.
- Participate in recruitment of students.
- Market the Industrial Maintenance and Electrical Systems program to regional employers and prospective students.
- Maintain active program advisory committee.
